- Exercising due diligence (as per below) when considering taking on new suppliers and undertaking reviews of our existing suppliers on a periodic basis.
 - Assessing the suppliers complete supply chain;
 - Evaluating the modern slavery stance of each new supplier; through being aware of the risks and the process to identify them.
